## Why you should apply for a fellowship or grant (in no particular order)

- It looks great on your CV.
- Fellowships may pay more than standard stipends, generally do not have requirements outside your research, and are not dependent on department or PI support.
- Forces you to clearly articulate your goals before beginning research.
- Provides an external review of your proposed research.
- Allows you to explore questions beyond your PI's interest and/or funding.
- Did I mention it looks great on your CV?

## How to apply for fellowships or grants

- Find an appropriate fellowship.
- Start early! Writing takes more time than you think.
- Solicit reviews of your proposal from your PI, other faculty, students, post docs, and experts in your field.
- Edit! The most important part of writing is rewriting.
- If required, identify the best references and give them adequate notice.
- Submit before the deadline, if at all possible.
- If at first you don't succeed, try again!
